UPDATED Quarantine Protocols for COVID-19

Below are the updated quarantine and safety protocols for Woodcrest School. These protocols have been aligned to meet the standards of the LA County Department of Public Health, and have been reviewed by the Woodcrest School Safety Committee.

As COVID-19 variants and case loads change, along with updated guidance by the LA County Department of Public Health, Woodcrest School will revise and adjust the protocols appropriately.

Students & Staff Who Test Positive for COVID-19 (regardless of vaccination status)

-Self-isolate for 5 days

-On day 5 if you have remained asymptomatic and have been fever free for the previous 24 hours, they can take an Antigen COVID-19 test*.

- If they receive a negative test result, they may return to school on Day 6 but must wear a medical grade mask for 5 days as long as symptoms are improving.

-If the test returns positive after day 5, stay home an additional 5 days.

OR

- Self-isolate for 10 days and return on Day 11 without testing (as long as fever-free and asymptomatic for 24 hours) prior to return.

Students & Staff Who Are Deemed a Close Contact of a Positive Case of COVID-19

If You Are Up to Date on Vaccination:

-Take an Antigen COVID-19 test on Day 0*.

-With a negative result, students and staff are permitted to come to school

- Wear a medical grade mask for five days

- On Day 5, take an Antigen COVID-19 test*.

Unvaccinated or partially vaccinated

- Stay home for 5 days and quarantine.

- On Day 5, take an Antigen COVID-19 test.

- If they receive a negative test result they may return to school on or after Day 6 but must wear a medical grade mask*.

Students & Staff Who Are a Household Contact of a Positive Case of COVID-19 (regardless of vaccination status)

- Stay home for 5 days and quarantine

- On Day 5, take an Antigen COVID-19 test*.

- If they receive a negative test result they may return to school on or after Day 6 and wear a medical grade mask for the next 5 days.

- If an additional member of the household tests positive, the 5-day quarantine period restarts

***A photo of the negative test will need to be provided to the school office.**

Note: Day 0 is the day the test sample was taken or the onset of symptoms.
